Uniform Policy

The School Governing Council has determined the School Dress Code policy in accordance with DfE Regulation 77. Governing Council strongly encourage parents/caregivers and students to support the uniform policy

Purpose

The purpose of our uniform is to ensure that students are dressed in a practical way that is suitable for a range of school activities and appropriate to the weather conditions. It ensures the inclusion of all students in the school's educational program, helps to develop pride in the school and encourages a sense of belonging.

Uniform

Uniform items with our school logo can be purchased from Devon Clothing Uniform Shop located at Shop 24 Clovercrest Plaza Shopping Centre, Montague Road Modbury 8350 7930. Items can also be purchased electronically through their online shop <https://onlineshop.devonclothing.com.au/highburyps>

Clothing in the school colours (Navy, Gold and Maroon) can also be purchased from local department stores.

We ask that parents/care providers dress students in suitable clothing which-

- Ensures the student's safety
- Withstands the rough and tumble of school playtime yet may be removed and put on easily
- Will not restrict or inhibit physical activity
- Is in line with our sun smart policy.

Good footwear is a necessity. Thongs and wedge-heeled shoes are not suitable footwear as students cannot run and play safely. Also for safety, lace-up shoes must be kept laced.

In line with the Governing Council Sun Smart Policy students are required to wear a hat in terms 1 and 4. Continued use during terms 2 and 3 is encouraged.

Jewellery is not encouraged however, discrete jewellery such as simple studs, watches or plain necklaces and bangles are acceptable. This supports health & safety standards appropriate for primary aged children.

Specific items

Foundation: All students starting at Highbury will be provided a bucket hat that is a different colour to the regular school hats. Students in foundation wear this hat during term 1. Families are encouraged to purchase a Highbury bucket hat with the relevant house team colour on the reverse side for Sports Day in term 3. All students will need to purchase a Highbury bucket hat ready for the start of Term 4. Highbury bucket hats are the only uniform item also available to purchase from the front office.

Graduating year level: All senior students in year 6 from 2022 will need to have at least one Highbury Seniors Polo shirt to wear for school photos and other special events throughout the year. Families also have the opportunity to purchase a commemorative seniors jumper which has all the names of the graduating year level on the back. Both items can be worn daily in conjunction with other uniform items.
