Tier 3: Major

Theft
Racism
Bullying
Physical violence
Leaving school grounds
Sexualised behaviour (refer to behaviour matrix)
Threatening behaviour/language
Property damage/misuse - Deliberate

RESPONSE OPTIONS - office blue slip:

Call office mobile for immediate danger
Relocate class if immediate danger to students/staff
Leadership support
Parent/ support system contact via leadership
Class re-entry assistance
Take home or suspension (Refer to SEE Procedure)
Return to class slip

Tier 2: Moderate

Repeated tier 1 behaviour

Disrespectful behaviours
(swearing, arguing, eyerolling etc.)

Late to class - repeated

Leaving class

RESPONSE OPTIONS - office blue slip:

Leadership support
Parent contact
Potential teacher/SSO support
Class re-entry assistance
Return to class slip

Tier 1: Mild

Not following instructions

Off task

Late to class

Class disruption/distraction

Accidental property damage/misuse

FIRST INSTANCE RESPONSES:

Proximity (move to student)

Re-direction
Verbal expectation reminder
1:1 'chat'
Change seat

REPEATED INSTANCE(S) RESPONSE

Reset (5-10 minutes)
In class or alternative class/space
