Uniform Policy

The School Governing Council has determined the School Dress Code policy in accordance with DfE Regulation 77. Governing Council strongly encourage parents/caregivers and students to support the uniform policy

Purpose

The purpose of our uniform is to ensure that students are dressed in a practical way that is suitable for a range of school activities and appropriate to the weather conditions. It ensures the inclusion of all students in the school's educational program, helps to develop pride in the school and encourages a sense of belonging.

Uniform

Uniform items with our school logo can be purchased from Devon Clothing Uniform Shop located at Shop 24 Clovercrest Plaza Shopping Centre, Montague Road Modbury 8350 7930. Items can also be purchased electronically through their online shop <https://onlineshop.devonclothing.com.au/highburyps>

Clothing in the school colours (Navy, Gold and Maroon) can also be purchased from local department stores.

We ask that parents/care providers dress students in suitable clothing which -

- Ensures the student's safety
- Withstands the rough and tumble of school playtime yet may be removed and put on easily
- Will not restrict or inhibit physical activity
- Is in line with our Sun Smart policy. i.e. It must be cool, loose fitting and made of closely woven fabric. Shirts should have a collar, and elbow length sleeves are recommended. Dresses, skirts and shorts should be longer style.

Good footwear is a necessity. Thongs, crocs and wedge-heeled shoes are not suitable footwear as students cannot run and play safely. Also for safety, lace-up shoes must be kept laced.

In line with the Sun Smart Policy students are required to wear a hat in terms 1, 3 and 4, and when the UV is above 3. Hats must not have a chin cord strap.

Jewellery is not encouraged however, discrete jewellery such as simple studs, watches or plain necklaces and bangles are acceptable. This supports health & safety standards appropriate for primary aged children. Lanyards that are not considered essential should not be worn during play time by students.





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Specific items

Hats: Families are encouraged to purchase a Highbury bucket hat with the relevant house team colour on the reverse side. Highbury bucket hats are available to purchase from the front office.

Highbury Primary branded clothing: Highbury Primary School beanies and scarves are available to be purchased from the front office. If choosing to wear these winter accessories, they must have the Highbury logo or be navy in colour.

Graduating year level: All senior students in year 6 will need to have at least one Highbury Seniors polo shirt to wear for school photos and other special events throughout the year. Families also have the opportunity to purchase a commemorative seniors jumper which has all the names of the graduating year level on the back. Both items can be worn daily in conjunction with other uniform items.

SAPSASA: Students that are selected to participate in SAPSASA carnivals may have the opportunity to purchase jumpers or polo shirts to commemorate the event. These items can only be worn on the next school day following the carnival and are not acceptable as regular school uniform.
